

四旬期第三主日

23/03/2025

每年四旬期的首两个主日我们都要默想耶稣在旷野中受魔鬼试探和耶稣在山上显圣容的事迹。但是，从第三个主日起，每年都有各自不同的逾越行程路线：甲年走的是洗礼新生命的行程；乙年走的是光荣十字架的行程；而今年丙年的行程则侧重于悔改和罪赦。这悔罪的行程首先是一个呼吁（路十三1-9），然后是等待（路十五1-3, 11-32），最后是赦免（若八1-11），而主导整个悔罪行程的就是天主。是天主邀请我们悔改，是天主在等待我们悔改，以及是天主要赦免我们的罪。这是天主爱人的奥秘。
